
SUMMER SEMINAR 2016 Activities to Enhance English Language Learning in the Summer Months

HOW CAN LENCOURAGE LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT?

The activities in this handout incorporate three important aspects of language:

1. RECEPTIVE LANGUAGE

The ability to understand language

- listening
- reading
- following directions

2. EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE

The ability to communicate using language

- speaking
- writing

3. SOCIAL LANGUAGE

The ability to use language socially

- conversation
- social skills





Receptive Skills Encourage your child to...

- Borrow books to read from the library
- Silent reading
- Take part in summer library programs (e.g. storytelling, reading groups)
- Watch television or movies in English
- Keep a written reading log
- Listen to English radio stations in the car
- Visit a museum



Expressive Skills Encourage your child to...

- Use simple question and answer phrases at home (e.g. "Pass me the ketchup please.")
- Take part in events and activities in your local area (e.g. farmer's markets, sports clubs, dance clubs)
- Keep a written log of words he or she does not understand, to learn more about over the summer
- Read aloud in English
- **Keep talking even if he or she makes mistakes**



Tips for Social Language Development Encourage your child to...

- Join a team sports club (soccer, baseball)
- Take part in individual sports clubs (tennis, swimming)
- Socialize with individuals from different backgrounds
