PAYDEN & RYGEL'S MATCHING GIFTS PROGRAM

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Gifts

The gift must be made in the form of cash, check, bank transfer or credit card. The program requires a minimum contribution of \$100, with the maximum contribution(s) eligible for matching funds in one calendar year at \$5,000.

Gifts where goods or services are received in kind will not be matched by the firm (i.e., you give \$100 for a fundraising drive and you receive CD's, play tickets, etc. in return).

Payden & Rygel reserves the right at any time and in its sole discretion to determine whether a gift shall be matched and to change or terminate the Matching Gifts Program without notice.

Donor Eligibility

Full-time employees of Payden & Rygel with continuous service during the six-month period preceding the date of the gift are eligible for the Matching Gifts Program.

ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATIONS

Educational Institutions

Any non-profit fully accredited primary, secondary or collegiate educational institution is eligible, including public schools, independent schools and specialized schools (i.e., schools for the disabled).

Gifts to schools for the construction of athletic facilities will be matched, but gifts to athletic departments for programs or scholarship are not eligible. Also ineligible are gifts matching tuition or dues.

Cultural Institutions

Approved institutions include museums, libraries, performing arts organizations, historical societies, botanical garden, zoos, public broadcasting or similar charitable cultural organization.

Hospitals

Eligible hospitals include any non-profit hospital accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations. An organization affiliated with an accredited hospital is also eligible; however, the check must be made to and received by the hospital and dispersed to the organization.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

USA and Territories

Institutions must be located in the United States or in a U.S. territory or possession in order to be eligible for the program. Exceptions are made for the international organizations with offices located in the United States and which use moneys to benefit in the United States.

Tax-Exempt Status

All approved institutions must be recognized as tax exempt by the Internal Revenue Service: most are listed in the Cumulative List of Organizations described in Section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. However, for any institution that has not previously received a matching gift from Payden & Rygel a proof of tax-exempt status must be submitted.

Ineligible Organizations

Payden & Rygel's Matching Gifts Program does not match gifts to civic organizations or organizations which are political in nature. Matching gifts to organizations involved in health care or health research (i.e., American Heart and Lung Association) are not permitted unless such organizations are affiliated with accredited hospitals. Human service agencies are not usually eligible; however, on occasion, exceptions may be made due to natural disasters.

Gift Processing

Request for matching gifts must be submitted on Payden & Rygel's Matching Gifts Form. Requisite information such as tax-exempt status, accreditation, etc. must be provided and accompany the form.
